The Broadcast Studio offers immediate access to global networks using ReadyCam®. Located on the Twin Cities campus, the studio enables experts to appear on live TV at a moment's notice without traveling to a network studio. Equipped with broadcast lighting, IP connectivity via VideoLink's Enhanced IP®, and a robotic camera, the studio is remotely controlled by VideoLink professionals who coordinate all aspects of the live shot.

Use of the Facility

The Broadcast Studio is equipped with VideoLink ReadyCam® technology for on-demand access for live or pre-taped interviews on breaking news, critical issues, or research discoveries. The studio services regional, national, and international media and is available for use 8 a.m.-5 p.m. Guests are encouraged to arrive 15 minutes prior to the start of their scheduled interview.

Staffing and use of the Broadcast Studio is complimentary when news media interview University of Minnesota faculty experts.

The studio is available to guests outside of the University for a nominal fee of \$200.
